### **Overview**

FVI School of Nursing and Technology offers prelicensure nursing programs designed to prepare graduates for licensure as a Practical Nurse (PN) or Registered Nurse (RN). Professional licensure requirements are established at the state level and are subject to change. In compliance with federal regulations (34 CFR §668.43), FVI provides the following disclosures regarding whether its programs meet educational requirements for licensure.

### **Student Location and Enrollment Limitation**

FVI operates in the State of Florida and enrolls only students who reside in Florida at the time of enrollment. FVI does not enroll, recruit, or advertise to students located outside the State of Florida.

### **State-by-State Determination**

Florida — Meets Educational Requirements

FVI has determined that its prelicensure nursing programs meet the educational requirements for licensure in the State of Florida and are approved by the Florida Board of Nursing.
